We would like to thank our generous Canadian partners whose support is integral to our work.





# DISTRIBUTION

In 2013 you sent medical, educational and food donations of over **\$3 million dollars** to people whose lives have been made better by your generosity.

Food For The Poor Canada partnered with Ontario Christian Gleaners, a group of Ontario **farmers** who donated their **vegetables** and **volunteers** who processed that into **3lb packages** of dehydrated **soup**. We shipped containers of the soup to Haiti to feed the hungry in orphanages, schools, prisons and churches.

You also sent soccer uniforms, sleeping mats, baby blankets, pencil crayons, books and even an ambulance.

This year students from three high schools in Kingston, Ontario raised the funds to build three homes for families in Kingston, Jamaica.
