

USEFUL VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

CANCELLATION POLICY

All donations received by Food For The Poor Canada are non-refundable. We make every effort to conduct builds as scheduled, but if Food For The Poor has to cancel a build the total amount paid will be applied to a future build.

If the cancellation is at the request of the volunteer, any donations paid by the volunteer may be applied to another build.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

It is highly recommended and it is the responsibility of the volunteer to book trip cancellation and international medical insurance. Food For The Poor Canada does not provide coverage.

MINORS

While youth participation is encouraged, Food For The Poor Canada asks that volunteers be at least 10 years old. All minors must be accompanied by a guardian on the build site. Guardians will need to complete a minor waiver form.

VACCINATIONS

Food For The Poor Canada recommends you speak to a travel clinic to review and decide what vaccinations may be needed for this region.

DRESS CODE

Close toe shoes, boots or hikers are required on the build site. It's recommended to wear a t-shirt and long pants, to protect yourself from scrapes and the sun. Hard hats and safety glasses are provided on site. You may want to bring a pair of work gloves.

BRINGING GIFTS

If you want to bring items to donate, we recommend bringing school supplies that will be shared and benefit all the students.
